This weekend, November 4th & 5th, is our campaign's ***Commitment Weekend!*** This is the weekend during which all members of our community are asked to make a decision as to how they will financially support the campaign.

We are off to a great start with over **\$1,083,000** already pledged from only **150** families. This represents **22%** of our campaign goal from only **5%** of our parish families – but we will need the support of all our members in order to achieve our total parish need.

We are asking every parish family to consider a pledge of **\$5,000** or more, payable over the next **5-years**. This is \$2.50 per day after an **optional** down payment of \$500. We realize that every family has different circumstances. Pledges of every amount are needed, welcomed and appreciated! Our goal is 100% participation!

If you have been financially blessed and are able to give more, please consider doing so. We need pledges of **\$10,000, \$15,000, \$25,000** and more in order to reach our goal and prepare for the future of our parish. Your generosity would be a blessing to our entire faith community.
