


FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME July 14, 2024

DEAR FRIENDS IN CHRIST,

As we journey through life, we often forget the profound implications of our baptismal vows. We become part of the family of the church, sharing in the threefold office of Christ: prophecy, priesthood, and kingship (1 Peter 2:5, 9-10).

We are not just mere believers but prophets to all nations, called to speak God's word and proclaim the Good News (Matthew 28:19). At St. Joseph Parish, we strive to embrace our Catholic identity and proclaim the Word of truth to all. At St. Joseph Parish, we're committed to being a beacon of truth, proclaiming the Word of God authentically and faithfully in all things. From liturgy, devotions, ministries, and facilities we aim to speak the prophetic Word of truth, love, and mercy with our presence and action. We invite you to join us in this mission, to participate fully in the life of the church. Let us boldly proclaim the Word of truth, just as Christ did, and facilitate encounters with Him (Romans 10:17). Together, we can be effective instruments of salvation for many. We can be the light in the darkness, the voice in the wilderness, and the hope in the midst of despair. We are prophets to all nations, called to speak God's word and change the world!

Come, let us embrace our prophetic calling and shine the light of Christ to all nations! Let us be the people of the word, speaking the language of God, and living the truth of our baptismal vows.

All the gifts of the Lord shall flow from the glory of God. Let us proclaim all the wonders we've seen: give thanks, rejoice and sing!


