

HAPPY CHRIST THE KING SOLEMNITY TO ALL!

DEAR ALL IN CHRIST,

Today, we celebrate a profound biblical truth cherished by Christians for centuries. This phrase, once uttered, sparked persecution in Mexico over a century ago, where Catholic priests, religious and faithful suffered for their unwavering faith.

José Sánchez del Río, a 14-year-old Mexican martyr, cried out "Viva Cristo Rey!" (Long live Christ the King!) before his execution in 1928. His courageous declaration echoes through history, reminding us of the enduring power of faith (Matthew 10:32-33). He chose to believe in the King of truth and love than the fear of the government who would kill him.

There is a prophecy about the coming of the new king in the Bible. In 2 Samuel 7:12-13, God promises King David: "I will raise up your offspring after you...and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever." Jesus embodies this prophecy, demonstrating authority, healing and resurrection power. He appears to be in control of all things visible and invisible. In John 18:37, before He dies, Jesus affirms His kingship to Pilate: "You say I am a king. For this reason, I came...to testify to the truth." Jesus' kingdom differs from worldly expectations. He does not rule the way earthly rulers do, but with truth and love.

Jesus reigns as the King of Truth, countering Satan's lies and deception (John 8:44). Satan's lies set in motion destruction of humanity as a whole which ripples through ages to come. We are aware that many lies have plagued humanity since Adam and Eve (Genesis 3:4-5). Some destructive lies today

include such as abortion justified as "choice," denying life's sanctity from conception or Gender ideology directly contradicting and opposing God's design (Genesis 1:27). Euthanasia disguised as "mercy killing" that under the pretext of mercy eliminates life at the most vulnerable time. We also know that false narratives about races and religions fueling hatred and division that lead to the death of millions worldwide.

However, Jesus' teachings offer freedom from falsehood: "The truth will set you free" (John 8:32). St. Peter was freed from his presumptions and denials of truth and served God and the church wholeheartedly. St. Paul was freed from his false religious zeal and became his great missionary. St. Mary Magdalene was free from her demons and became the first proclaimer of the resurrection. People were free from sins as they encountered the Truth. The truth will set us free! Thus, when we proclaim Christ our King, we accept His authority, teachings and guidance. Christ rules with truth and love, healing souls broken by lies and deception (Isaiah 61:1-3). He frees us from sin's slavery, offering abundant blessings and freedoms to be the Father's beloved sons and daughters (Romans 5:17).

Let us sincerely declare, "Viva Cristo Rey!" and live accordingly. May the Lord grant you peace, joy and happiness as we follow our King.





Youth & Children's Choirs: Empowering our younger members to participate in and lead worship through song, fostering faith and confidence in the next generation.


Bell Choir: Adding a joyful and unique dimension to our musical offerings, where the beauty of handbells resonates throughout the sanctuary.

THE ST. JOSEPH CHAPEL OF HEALING: The Missionary Path

Inspired by the Lord's compassion and mercy, we've undertaken an ambitious renewal project, centered around the reconstruction of the St. Joseph Chapel of Healing. Why healing? We recognize that sin and life's challenges wound us, but our merciful Lord invites us to come to Him (Matthew 11:28-30). Saint Joseph is also the hope of the sick. As a man, Jesus learned love and compassion from His family, His mother Mary, foster father Joseph, and grandparents Joachim and Ann. Within this chapel, you'll encounter the Holy Family, praying alongside relics that witness their lives:

- 1. A relic from Joachim and Ann's house: This relic originates from the ancestral home of the Holy Family in Nazareth, where Jesus' grandparents raised Mary. The Church of the Nutrition marks the spot where the angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she would bear a son (Luke 1:26-38). This relic connects us to the roots of our faith.
- 2. A relic from Saint Joseph's carpentry shop: This relic comes from the workshop where Saint Joseph taught Jesus the trade of carpentry. Saint Joseph's carpentry shop is believed to be located near the Church of the Annunciation in Nazareth. This site commemorates the Holy Family's life in Nazareth.
- 3. A relic from the room where Mary received the Annunciation: This relic originates from the very room where the angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she would bear Jesus. The Annunciation is celebrated as a pivotal event in Christian tradition (Luke 1:26-38). This relic bridges the gap between heaven and earth.
- 4. An original painting of the Blessed Virgin Mary dating back to the 17th century and restored in 1987. Surrounded by the symbols of the Litany of Loreto which derives its name from the Shrine of Virgin in Loreto, Italy. The Holy House of the Virgin and the Holy Family had been miraculously transported from Nazareth to Loreto in 1294. The Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary dates as far back as 1531 and has many positive results in our lives when prayed. - 5. Eight Healing Miracles. To commemorate Christ's healing power, we've commissioned local artists from diverse backgrounds and cultures to create paintings depicting eight significant healing miracles:
 - 1. Healing of the child (Jairus' daughter) Mark 5:21-43
 - 2. Healing of two blind men Matthew 9:27-31
 - 3. Healing of the woman with the alabaster jar Luke 7:36-50
 - 4. Healing of the leper Matthew 8:1-4
 - 5. Healing of the paralyzed man Luke 5:18-25
 - 6. Healing of the crippled woman Luke 13:10-13
 - 7. Healing of Peter's Mother-in-Law Luke 4:38-39
 - 8. Healing of the Syrophoenician's daughter Matthew 15:22-28

These works of art capture the universality of Christ's healing and the individuality of those seeking His touch.

In summary, in this sacred space, you are invited to experience:

- **Healing and forgiveness** through the intercession of the holy family.
- Spiritual renewal through prayer and reflection
- Communion with the Holy Family, embracing their love and wisdom
- Renewal of heart and spirit, surrendering to God's mercy.

Join us on this pilgrimage, and may the Lord's compassion envelop you. Visit the St. Joseph Chapel of Healing at the Diocesan Shrine of St. Joseph, Mission San José, Fremont, and let the Lord's love transform your life.


