DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

Death is an inevitable part of life, yet it remains a difficult and depressing reality for many of us to face. As a priest, I have had the privilege of visiting with parishioners who are struggling with illness and the prospect of death. Recently, the passing of a close friend hit me hard, and I was reminded of the pain and sadness that accompanies loss.

However, as Christians, we have a unique perspective on death. We believe in the resurrection of the body, and the hope of eternal life with God. This hope makes the reality of death bearable, and even transforms it into a moment of triumph and victory. As St. Paul reminds us in 1 Corinthians 15:17, "If Christ has not been raised, our faith is in vain, and we are the most pitiful people in the world." But our Lord has shown us that it is possible to overcome death, and that our bodies will be raised again. This is a matter of faith, and it gives us the courage to face death with hope and confidence.

So, the question is no longer what happens after death, but rather how should we live our lives now, knowing that they will come to an end. This is a profound and exciting reality, and it is entirely within our power to choose how we want to live. We can choose to live a meaningless and miserable existence, or we can embark on an adventure


