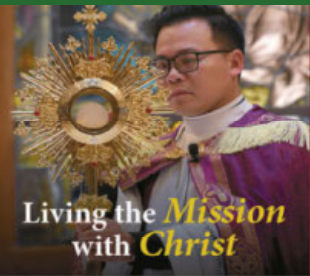

LOVING YOUR ENEMY:  
A RADICAL ACT OF COMPASSION

DEAR FRIENDS IN CHRIST,

In a world where division and strife often dominate the headlines, Jesus' command to "love your enemies" (Matthew 5:44) can seem like a daunting, even impossible, task. Yet, this radical call to love is at the very heart of the Gospel message.

So, what does it mean to love your enemy? It means recognizing the inherent dignity of the human person in each individual, regardless of their actions or beliefs. It means seeing the spark of divine life that resides within every person, even those who may have wronged or hurt us.

Loving your enemy also means refusing to condemn or judge them. Instead, we are called to approach them with empathy, understanding, and compassion. This doesn't mean excusing or justifying their behavior, but rather recognizing that they, like us, are complex and multifaceted human beings.

Ultimately, loving your enemy means being open to forgiveness. Forgiveness is not about forgetting or dismissing the harm that has been done, but about releasing the hold that anger, resentment, and bitterness have on our hearts. When we forgive, we create space for healing, reconciliation, and new life to emerge.

In a world that often values revenge and retribution, loving your enemy is a radical act of defiance. It is a declaration that we will not be bound by the cycles of hatred and violence, but will instead choose to walk the path of love, compassion, and forgiveness. As we strive to love our enemies, may we be inspired by the words of Saint Teresa of Calcutta: ***"I have found the paradox, that if you love until it hurts, there can be no more hurt, only more love."***

Every 25 years the Catholic Church declares a Holy Year of Jubilee. The pope opens special holy doors in the four major basilicas in Rome: St. Peter's, St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major, and St. Paul's. Thousands of pilgrims come to Rome to process through one or



more of these holy doors, confess their sins, receive the Eucharist, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. By making this spiritual pilgrimage, the

faithful may gain a plenary indulgence: remission of the temporal punishment due to their sins. In the Diocese of Oakland, the Cathedral of Christ the Light, Oakland and **Mission San José in Fremont** are permanently designated sites for every day of the 2025 Holy Year.
